Tournament Guidelines

BOOKING GUIDELINES

- Tournaments are accepted on select Monday's and Thursday's
- Customized tournament packages are available to suit your specific requirements.
- A non-refundable deposit of \$2500.00 and a signed contract are required to confirm a tournament booking.
- All tournaments shall be for a minimum of 104 golfers.
- All tournament competitions, scoring and golf requirements must be finalized seven (7) days prior to the tournament.
- A guaranteed number of guests are required five (5) business days prior to the tournament. If no guarantee is received, billing will be done based on the contract attendance or actual if higher. Conditions apply. Please see complete terms and conditions.
- A completed list of all tournament players including first and last names and any female players, is required 72 hours prior to your tournament.

SHOTGUN TOURNAMENTS

- All shotgun tournaments are scheduled to start at 1:30 p.m.
- Course buyouts for earlier and alternative start times are available. Please inquire.
- Players must be ready to proceed to their designated tee 30 minutes before the start of the tournament.

ON COURSE SIGNAGE & SET UP

- Quilchena Golf and Country Club (QGCC) will provide and setup a maximum of 8 on course competitions markers (KP, LD & SD).
- QGCC will provide and setup a maximum of 6 on course amenity stations to include a 6' table with linen, patio umbrella with stand and two white padded folding chairs.
- Hole sponsorship signs and registration banner must be delivered at least 48 hours prior to the tournament.
- All hole sponsorship signs must be free standing or "H" wire election type signs.
- QGCC may at its sole discretion, refuse to place any sign which it deems not compliant with its standards.
- It is the responsibility of the tournament organizer to insure all personal items are removed from the golf course at the completion of play. QGCC is not responsible for loss or damage of personal items left behind.
- All tournament signage left at the club for more than a week following the tournament will be discarded.
- Hole-in-One vehicle(s) must be delivered a minimum of 5 hours prior to tee-off. All vehicles must be placed on course by Club staff only.
- Correct hole-in-one yardage as per insurance requirements is required at least 48 hours prior to the tournament.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

- All tournaments will play as scheduled, regardless of weather, unless the Course Superintendent of QGCC, in his sole determination, closes the golf course due to unplayable or hazardous conditions.
- QGCC Course Superintendent may limit golf cart access on the golf course to CART PATHS ONLY in whole or in part due to conditions that may result in turf damage.

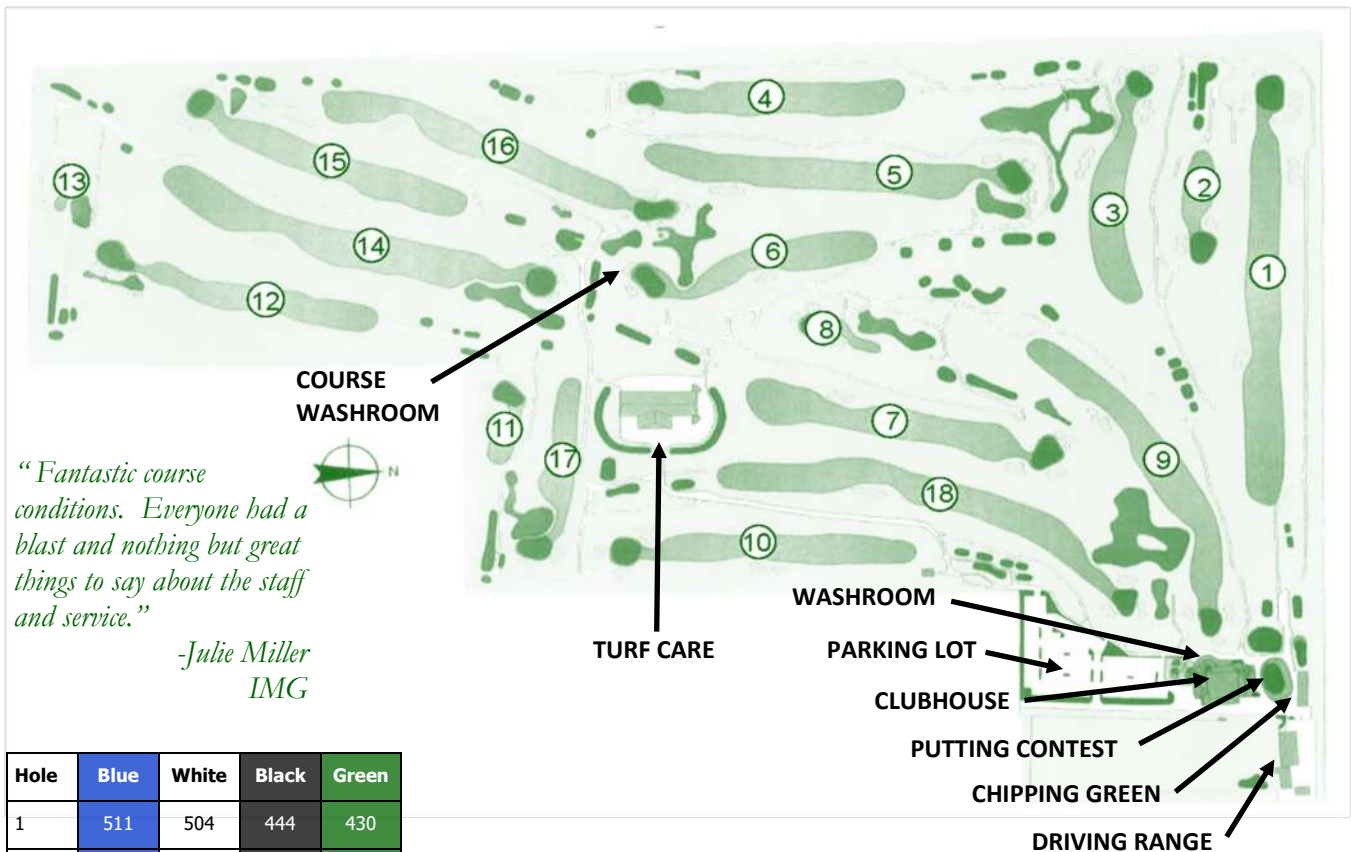

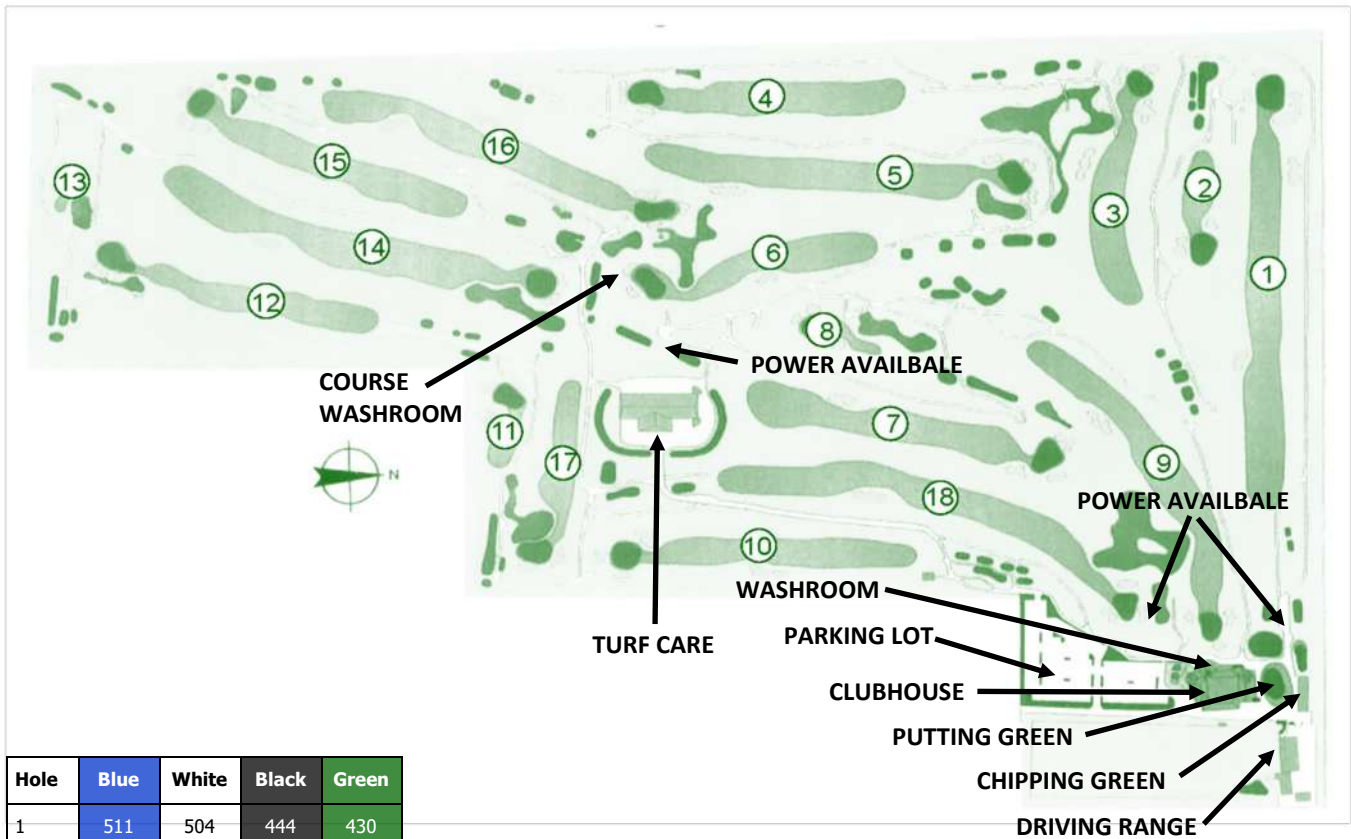

Club Policies

GENERAL RULES

- The tournament host is responsible for communicating the rules and regulations of QGCC to all tournament players, guests and volunteers in advance of the tournament.
- Club staff are empowered to enforce all rules and reserve the right to deny any player, guest or volunteer entry onto the golf course and or clubhouse for not adhering to the Club rules.

ETIQUETTE RULES

- The tournament host shall be responsible for the conduct and behavior of all tournament players, guests and volunteers on Club property.
- The use of language and or behavior inconsistent with the values of golf is not allowed. Discriminatory, racist, offensive, obscene, vulgar, profane, inflammatory, or unlawful language, behavior or conduct is unacceptable and may result in immediate removal from Club property.

GOLF COURSE DRESS CODE

Quilchena aims to provide a relaxed and contemporary atmosphere for its members and guests through a progressive dress policy inspired by the professional golf tour.

- Metal spikes are not allowed on the golf course. Soft spikes only.
- Hats and caps must be worn as they were designed.
- Athletic team style attire is not permitted.
- Any clothing with offensive slogans is not permitted.
- Denim clothing, tennis shorts, sweat pants, hoodies, rugby pants, cut-offs, cargo pants or shorts, t-shirts, tank tops, shirts with slogans, numbers or illustrations, halter tops, tank tops, yoga pants or leggings and shear or spandex clothing are prohibited dress on the golf course.
- Each player must have their own set of golf clubs, whether personal or rented.
- Club management shall have the final say in determining the appropriateness of any clothing and is empowered by the Board to inform, educate and if necessary to enforce the dress policy.

CLUBHOUSE DRESS CODE

- Smart, casual dress and or appropriate golf attire.
- Footwear must be worn at all times. Golf shoes cannot be worn inside the Clubhouse.
- All headwear must be removed on the upper level of the clubhouse.

WIRELESS DEVICES

- All wireless devices must be placed in the silent or vibrate only mode when on the golf course.
- Wireless devices are not to be used in the men's and women's lounges or in any dining areas of the clubhouse.
